Ministry Update - July, 2011

As you may know from our last newsletter in December 2010, Susan and I had returned to the US for family needs after the death of both our fathers. We took Susan's 90 year old mother into our home to care for her. I then had a heart attack and have been under treatment since that time. We have prayerfully made the decision to continue my Christian counseling work from here in the US at this time. **I have also made a new partnership agreement with One Another Ministries** which allows me to continue helping missionaries by traveling several times a year to minister to them abroad. We are using funds in our existing account and raising additional funds for travel expenses to these ministry projects as needed.

RECENT MINISTRY PROJECTS:

On June 9th I traveled to France to help missionaries who attended a retreat in eastern France. This was a very productive time counseling and debriefing missionaries from Haiti, Asia, and Indonesia. Some had gone through some very difficult times including the Haiti earthquake. I just returned from this ministry project on June 30th. I also recently counseled with several missionaries and Christian workers on leave or working here in the USA. God is expanding and blessing this ministry outreach every week.

Location Changed but Ministry Focus Unchanged

As you see from our updated photo we are changing and getting older! However, while we are in a US location now, we will continue our ministry to Christian workers and missionaries both here and abroad. This is a new chapter in our lives and we want to "bloom where we are planted".
